We are allowed to host events in the Round Barn under the conditions provided by the Village in our conditional use permit. Dennis and I have also put conditions on ourselves in regards to managing the facility ensuring neighbors are able to enjoy their environment.

ROUND BARN UPDATE

The next step was seeking state approval to use the barn for functions. That was scary and a big hurdle, with many sleepless nights. There are several facilities like Willow being created all over the state and the state is still determining how to handle these facilities. Out of the blue a gentleman from the State called us with all the answers we needed. He provided us with a letter allowing us to host events in the Round Barn. Thank you to whoever asked him to give us a call! Through all of this we have learned that Dennis' decisions on the barn's reconstruction are far ahead of others in Wisconsin.

As we continue restoration, we are pushing hard on completing a set of bathrooms in the lower level, as well as building gardens to enhance the natural beauty of the area. Many of you may have notice the large dirt pile being created; a sound and light barrier for our community.
